


- Understand how your skills and MOS line up to Civilian Jobs







What Can You Gain from 020?	 Industry validated training and credentials aligned to three initial learning pathways, Business Management, Customer Excellence, and Information Technology One-on-one career counselling and interview coaching Interview with an O2O employer partner
What Does 020 Require?	 A signed O2O Application from your unit leadership (active duty only) Completion of TAP GPS program prior to cohort start date (active duty only) Time and effort committed to the program Be responsive to program advisors and coaches


